Eligibility:

PG Scholars Competition: Open to all current M.D./M.S./Ph.D. scholars.

BAMS Students Competition: Open to all current BAMS students and house surgeons





Abstract Submission Guidelines

We invite abstract submissions for oral presentations on the following topics:

For PG Scholars:

- “Interpreting Gastrointestinal Disorders through the Lens of Ayurvedic Guna Siddhanta”
- “Exploring and Evaluating Agni and Koshta in Samana and Shodana Chikitsa”

For BAMS Students:

- “Guna & Karma Vikalpa of Ayurvedic Herbs in Gastrointestinal Healing”
- “Ayurvedic Dietetics: Promoting Gut Health for Long-Term Wellness”

Abstract Structure:

Your abstract should be clear, concise, and structured under the following headings:

- **Title:** Provide a concise and descriptive title reflecting the focus of your work.
- **Background & Objectives:** Briefly explain the context and significance of the study.
- **Methodology:** Describe the approach used (e.g., literary review).
- **Key Findings / Results:** Summarize your study's main results or insights.
- **Conclusion and Relevance:** State the conclusions drawn from your findings. Emphasize the clinical or practical relevance of your work to Ayurveda practice.

Length and Formatting:

- **Word Limit:** The abstract should be between 300–500 words (excluding the title and author details).
- **Font:** Use Times New Roman, 12-point font size.
- **Language:** Abstracts must be submitted in English.
- **File Format:** Submit the abstract as a Word document (.doc or .docx).

Author Information:

- Include the full names, affiliations of all authors, and contact details (email and phone number).
- Indicate the presenting author.
- Provide contact details of the presenting author (email and phone number).





Evaluation Criteria

Abstracts will be evaluated based on:

- Relevance to the topic.
- Clarity and originality of content.
- Scientific rigor and methodology.
- Potential contribution to Ayurveda practice and research.

Selection Criteria

- **Abstract Submission & Screening:** All submitted abstracts will undergo an initial screening process.
- **Online Presentation:** Selected abstracts under each category will be invited to present online as part of the preliminary round. (Participants who present their work will receive an oral presentation certificate)
- **Final Selection:** The top 5 participants (each category) from the online presentations will be chosen to deliver in-person oral presentations at the conference.

Awards

- **First and Second Prize Winners:**

Winners in each category (PG Scholars and BAMS Students) will receive a cash award, memento, and certificate. A cash prize of Rs. 10,000 will be awarded for the first prize, and Rs. 5,000 for the second prize.

- **Finalists:**

All 5 finalists in each category will be reimbursed their full registration fee, and certificate.

Please ensure your submission adheres to the guidelines and deadlines for the best chance of being selected for the final round.
